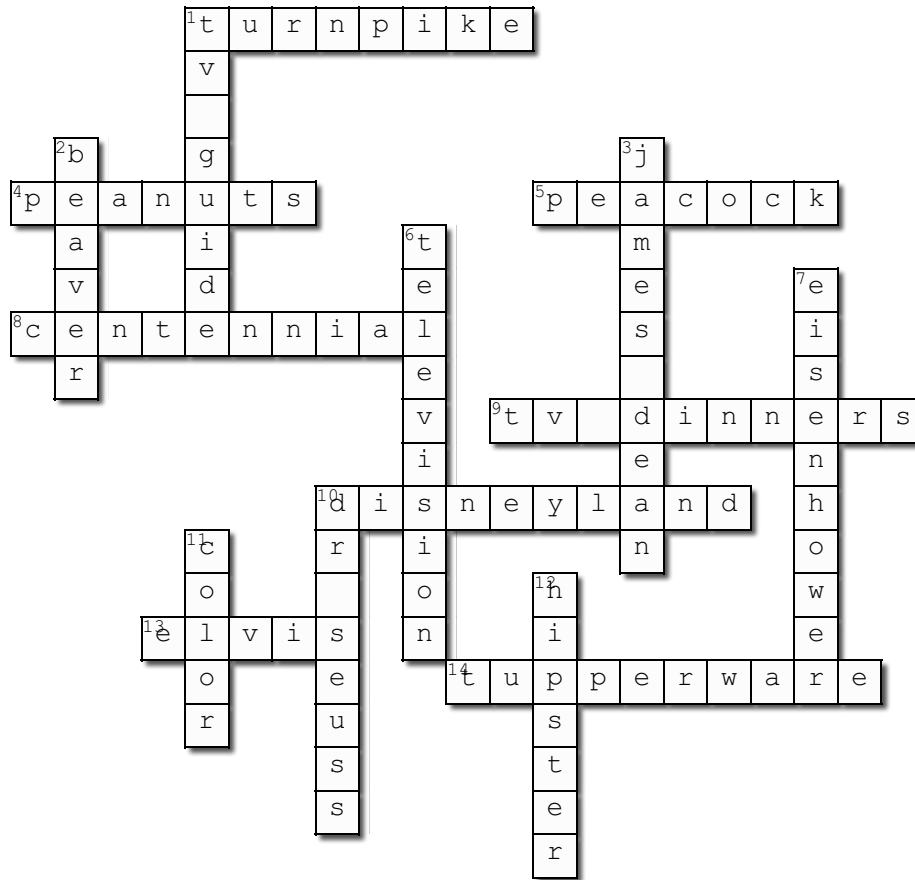


# The 1950s
