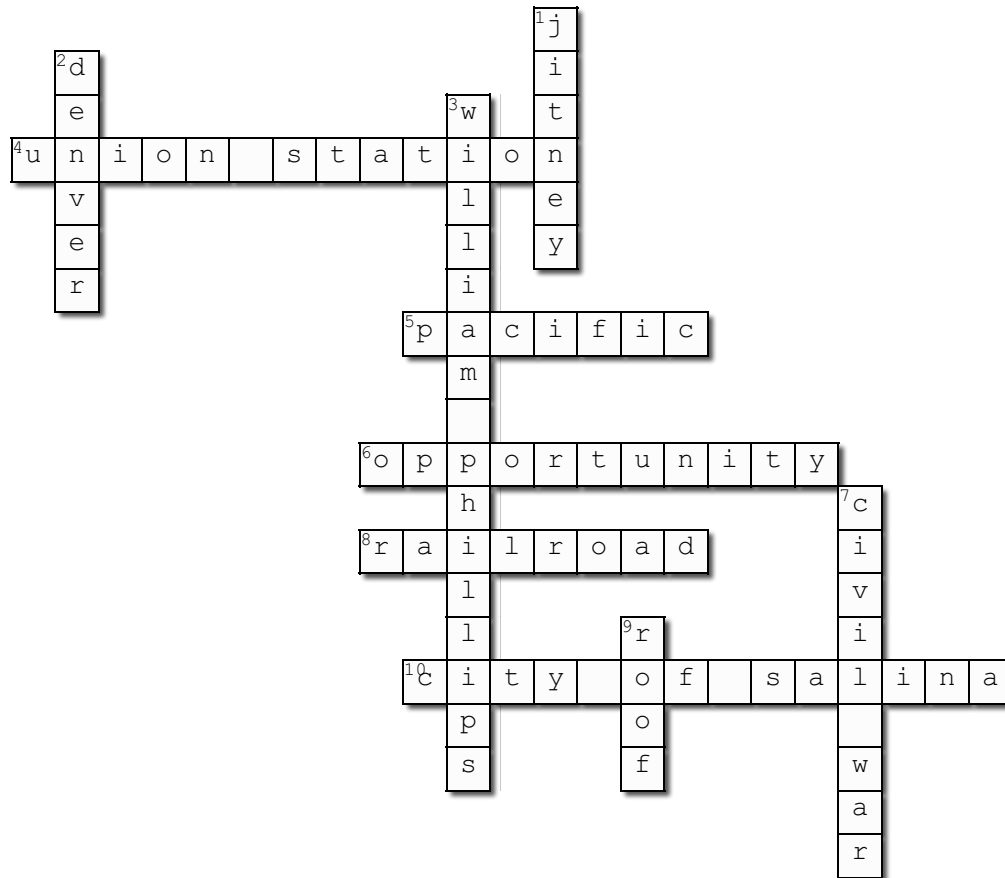


The Railroad in Salina
